

Also please reach out if you need an additional copy of the screening report for your provider.

INCOMPLETE PAPERWORK: Over the next several weeks I will be reviewing charts and sending reminders for students that are missing physical, dental, and/or lead forms. Please have this medical paperwork completed at your earliest convenience and return it to Warren ES, Attention: School Nurse. If you need help with obtaining general medical care for your child, please reach out to me so

that I can connect you to the Baltimore County Health Department for assistance.

A REMINDER FOR OUR STUDENTS, PER BCPS POLICY: Students may not return to school after running a fever greater than 100.0 F until they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
